



CALL FOR NOMINATIONS GAB HALL OF FAME

DEADLINE IS FRIDAY, March 11, 2010

This is a call for nominations to our GAB Hall of Fame. Induction into the GAB Hall of Fame is the highest honor bestowed by the Association. While there are no formal qualifications, the general considerations used to select Hall of Fame members are:

- ★ History of active involvement in the broadcast industry.
- ★ Significant contribution(s) to the broadcast industry.
- ★ Emphasis placed on serving, and contributing to, the broadcast community and general population of Georgia.

Nominations should include a detailed history of the person being nominated. A Nomination Form, which includes a listing of past Hall of Fame recipients, may be used as guidance for submission of nominee credentials. Click [HERE](#) to download.

There is no requirement that there be inductees each year. The committee determines each year if there will be inductees from those nominated and may choose to induct more than one.
