



CALL FOR NOMINATIONS 2008 GAB HALL OF FAME

DEADLINE IS FRIDAY, OCTOBER 3

This is a call for nominations to our GAB 2008 Hall of Fame. Induction into the GAB Hall of Fame is the highest honor bestowed by the Association. While there are no formal qualifications, the general considerations used to select Hall of Fame members are:

- ★ History of active involvement in the broadcast industry.
- ★ Significant contribution(s) to the broadcast industry.
- ★ Emphasis placed on serving, and contributing to, the broadcast community and general population of Georgia.

Nominations should include a detailed history of the person being nominated. The attached Nomination Form, which includes a listing of past Hall of Fame recipients, may be used as guidance for submission of nominee credentials.

There is no requirement that there be inductees each year. The committee determines each year if there will be inductees from those nominated and may choose to induct more than one. Nominations not chosen remain in the file for two additional years for future consideration. The following names have been previously nominated and remain in the file for current consideration:
